



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR LEADERS

PLEASE REVIEW THE PROGRAM AND FINANCIAL DETAILS LISTED ON YOUR CONTRACT, specifically noting: date(s), start/end times, meals provided, deposit, balance due, etc. Also, let our Booking Director know *before* arrival of any **food allergies** or special needs for participants.

Upon your arrival, Eagle Rock staff will need to collect from you the **FINAL PAYMENT AND MEDICAL INFORMATION/LIABILITY RELEASE FORM** for each participant (including adults). BOTH FRONT AND BACK must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian if participant is under 18 years of age. These are REQUIRED!! Participants without medical/release forms will **not** be allowed to participate (no exceptions)!

Minimum age of participant varies with the type of program. Minimum age for all activity participants is 11 years. No exceptions unless by approval of the Administrator of Eagle Rock.

Please have participants leave CD players, IPODS, etc., at home. Use of such devices is not permitted at Eagle Rock. It is the policy of Eagle Rock that **campers do not use the camp phone** while on retreat.. ***Please inform your parents before departing, that you will call your church or school only to confirm your group's arrival.*** Chaperones may use the phone for personal use, if they bring a phone card or call collect. (Cell phones do not pick up a signal here in the mountains.) For a complete list of what participants need to provide, please see specific program description and/or itinerary.

Participants need *not* be in prime physical shape to enjoy many of Eagle Rock's activities, but **good fitness** will enhance levels of personal comfort and satisfaction. Some programs (e.g. rock climbing) allow participants to choose their own level of difficulty/challenge while others (e.g. hiking) are fairly equally demanding on all participants.

Program activities will be carefully structured around the needs of the participants and will provide numerous "teachable moments." These opportunities for personal, social, and spiritual growth will be facilitated by trained staff. However, it is encouraged that you bring your own staff/chaperones along with you. This will allow for quality follow-up of the growth experienced. You and your staff will join in the activities as participants. This will provide a unique opportunity for your group members to see you as a co-learner as well, rather than as an authority figure.

The Eagle Rock staff will be the final authority on your trip. We know that you will enjoy getting to know us and we, in turn will appreciate your input and insights tremendously! We view our service to you as service to Christ, and have a heart for ministry. May God be glorified as we team together for this time of ministry to others.
